

SÖREN ROGGENBAU (DVG)



Sören started training at the age of 14 with his Standard Schnauzer *Anton von der Kasseburg*.

Sören competed repeatedly with Anton in the German Championships in Tournament Sport and placed first three times. He also competed in other trials and won the Seniors Class in Tournament Sport several times. He passed the BH trial 20 times and participated in 40 Tournament Sport competitions.

In 1993, Sören started his work as protection helper and continues to do helper work in several clubs. At one point he was the protection helper and training director for 4 clubs simultaneously. In 1996, Sören bought *Niklas vom Pinzeshof* with whom he competed in the World Championships for Riesenschnauzer (17th place) and participated in the German Championships for RS (7th and 10th place). Unfortunately Niklas had to be euthanized at the age of 7 after a serious illness. During this time, Sören also trained a pepper-salt RS from a VPG 1 to a VPG 3 (in 12 months) and has handled German Shepherds and other breeds.

Sören has held the position of helper and training director in the PSK Group of Stade, protection helper in an SV Club and PSK Director of Dog Sports for Northern Germany. He has been a trial judge since 2005 and a Körmeister since March 2008. He's judged several State Championships, the German FH Championships and the German Championships in Phase C.

Sören has judged Schnauzerfest 2008 and 2016. He still breeds and trains the Riesenschnauzer under the kennel name Riesenschnauzer Vom Ravener Forst <http://www.vom-ravener-forst.de/>
