

HANS KARL SCHNEIDER – CONFORMATION JUDGE



Mr. Schneider grew up on a farm with lots of animals. His father got him his first German Pinscher. 1963 Mr. Schneider joined the PSK. For 32 years he successfully bred German Pinscher and also assisted Werner Jung with his kennel 'von der Birkenheide.

In the years and decades after the war, breeding and restructuring of the PSK had to be started from the ground up. During this time the German Pinschers from the kennel "vom Haingraben" achieved many national and international titles and were used in many countries to help them develop the breed.

Since 1965 Mr. Schneider has been breed warden in the PSK, first for his local group and then for the state of Hessen. He is the President of the PSK Hessen.

Over the years, Mr. Schneider held the following positions in the PSK: Breed Warden, Commissioner for HD-matters and is currently Chief of Breed Judges.

Mr. Schneider has been judging the PSK breeds since 1970.
